Dear Anindya and David,

This letter is to request the release of UVA capital equipment (see attached asset list) purchased with my Burroughs-Wellcome or NIH funding sources. One exception Is the Amersham SMART chromatography system purchased with ETF/start-up funds in 2000. Notably this instrument, and training in its use, has been exclusively in the Grant lab, and the equipment Is discontinued and has not been supported by GE/Amersham for many years. This instrument very likely will be otherwise surplused. All of this equipment was collectively purchased between 2000 and 2009 and has no asset value as of the last inventory date of 12/2018. Other equipment potentially useful to other investigators will remain at UVA.

I will be transferring my laboratory to Florida Atlantic University and this equipment is necessary for completion/continuation of research projects. The attached UVA Equipment Inventory change request form (P-1) has the specific fixed asset detail, receiving institute information, and UVA procurement detail.
